Ask me about....

Reading

The children have made a great start and they are showing a lot of grit to learn all the set 1 sounds. The children have learnt more than half of the set 1 sounds and they are beginning to use "Fred Talk" to read CVC words. While we are still learning the rest of set 1 sounds, the children will be choosing a book from our book corner to take home. Whilst reading this book with your child, ask them questions about what is happening during the story, what could happen and can they point out the sounds they have learnt so far. The children can independently change the book when they feel they have finished. By sharing stories at home, this will promote their love of reading. I will send out a date in the near future for a parent phonic workshop to help you support your child's reading at home.
