

Dear Parents,

I thought it would be helpful if I wrote to you about the home learning for Class 2. As per Miss McCann's letter, Monday's timetable will be a lot less comprehensive, however from Tuesday there will be a full timetable with video tutorials and specific tasks. We have decided to separate the Maths lessons into year 1 and year 2 along with spellings and mental maths. I will contact you separately if your child should be completing work from the opposite year group to the one they are in. The English work and afternoon work will be accessible for both year groups. Below are the timetables that we will be following.

Miss McCann's letter also mentioned sending your child's work to us daily. If this is not possible, please do let us know and we can make a different arrangement.

As you are hopefully aware, Miss Keenor is completing her teaching training with us this year so we would like her to be involved in receiving some of the work, replying and awarding raffle tickets. Therefore, could I ask that if your child is completing the year 1 work then please email both me and Miss Keenor on the email addresses at the bottom of this page. I will be looking at all emails, but Miss Keenor will be responsible for replying to the emails from those completing the year 1 work. If you have any specific questions, queries or need additional support then please do feel free to address the email just to me. If your child is completing the year 2 work, then just email me.

For the reading sessions, your child will either need to complete the Read, Write, Inc phonics (RWI) session or the guided reading task. I will email you all separately to let you know which group your child is in and what colour RWI book they need to read. The RWI sessions comprises of two parts. For the first part they will need to watch the 'speed sounds session' for their set (your child will fall into either set 1, 2 or 3 and I will let you know this). The links for the speed sounds session will be on the timetable and you will need to help your child to select the right set. The second part of the RWI session is to read a RWI book including the speed sounds, green words and red words.

If your child is not in a RWI group then they will only need to complete the guided reading work, they do not need to watch any phonics videos or read any of the RWI books although of course they can if they want to!

Please also note that we do not use Mathletics, we only use MyMaths. The login for MyMaths should be in your child's reading record but if it is not, then please let me know and I can send it to you.
