Image Consent Form for Tapestry

We may take photographs for a number of reasons whilst your child is with us and you have already signed a permission form for these various uses.

At Four Elms Primary School we use a learning journal called Tapestry to reflect your child's time in Reception. It will include photographs of your child at play with other children, for example in a group of children creating mud pies in the mud kitchen, or building a race track for the cars.

In order to comply with GDPR, we need your permission before we can photograph or make any recordings of your child.
