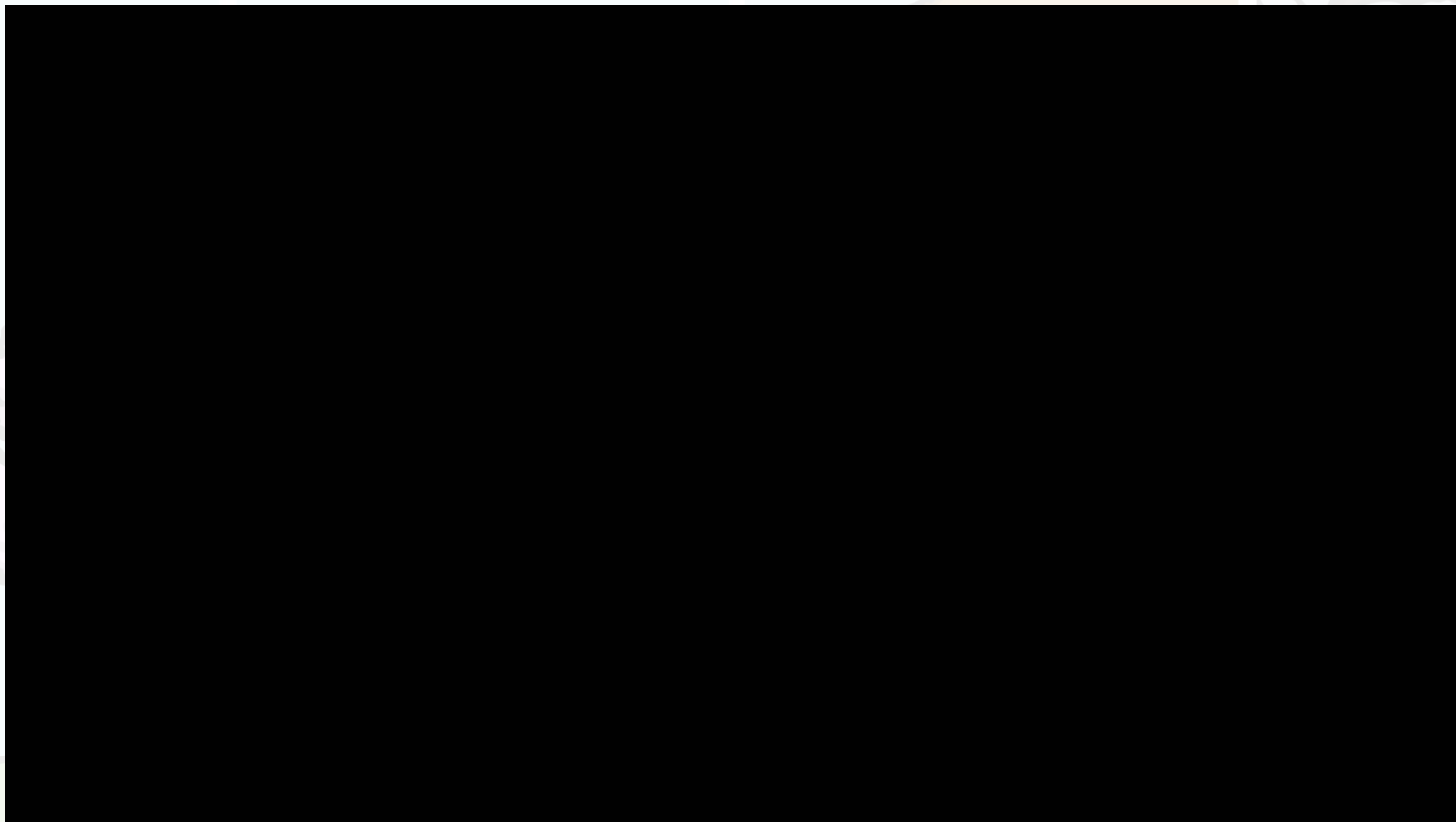




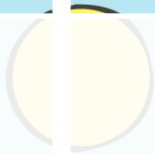
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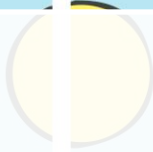


# Changing Season

# Day Length



Bonfire Night happens in autumn, on the 5<sup>th</sup> November.

| Hours of sunlight | 13   | 11  | 9   | 8   | 8   | 10  | 12  | 14    | 15  | 16   | 16   | 14  |

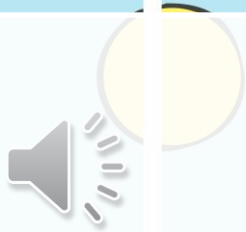




# Spring

- As the seasons change from winter to spring, plants begin to grow and the weather begins to get warmer.
- March, April and May are the months of spring.
- The leaves on the trees begin to grow.
- As winter turns to spring the days get longer and the nights get shorter.

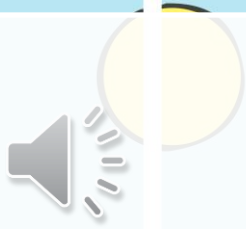




# Summer

- As the seasons change from spring to summer plants have grown and the weather begins to get even warmer.
- June, July and August are the months of summer.
- As spring turns to summer the days get longer and the nights get shorter.
- The longest day of the year is in summer.





# Autumn

- As the seasons change from Summer to Autumn the temperature begins to fall, which means it gets colder.
- The leaves on some trees change colour and begin to fall to the ground.
- As summer turns to autumn, the days get shorter and the nights get longer.
- The autumn months are September, October and November





# Winter

- As the seasons change from autumn to winter the temperature begins to fall, which means it gets even colder.
- Overnight temperatures can fall low enough for it to freeze and we notice frost and ice in the mornings.
- Many trees have lost their leaves and their branches are bare.
- As autumn turns to winter the days get shorter and the nights get longer. Winter has the shortest days and the longest nights of all the seasons.
- The winter months are December, January and February.
- The shortest day of the year is in winter.
