- It is meant to be stormy later.

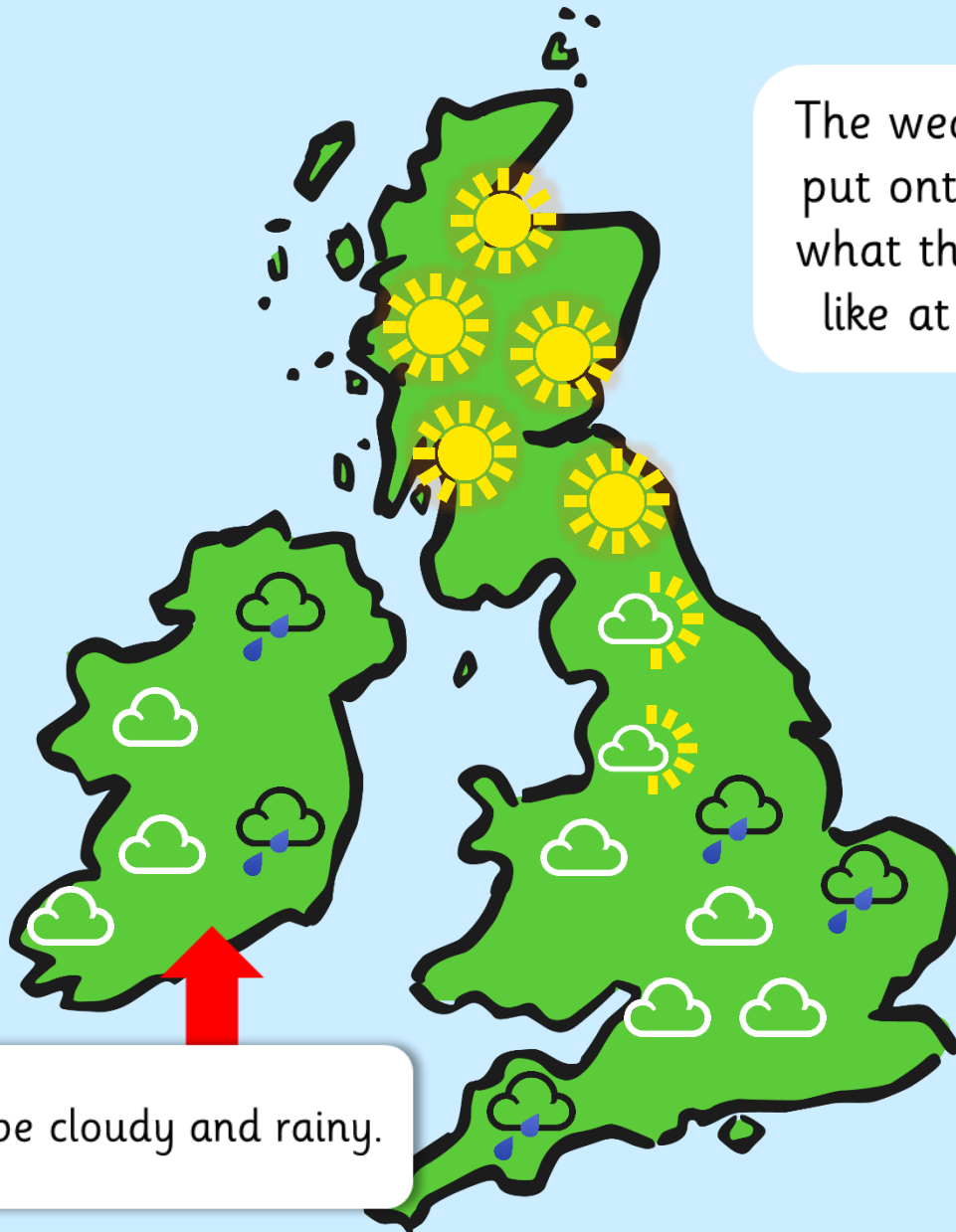
Weather forecasts



A statement of what the weather is likely to be for the next day or few days, usually broadcast on television or radio or printed in a newspaper.



The weather symbols are put onto a map to show what the weather will be like at different places.



In Ireland it will be cloudy and rainy.

Sometimes you need to know more detail about the weather through the day.

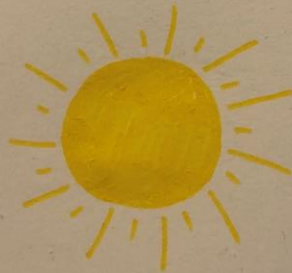
