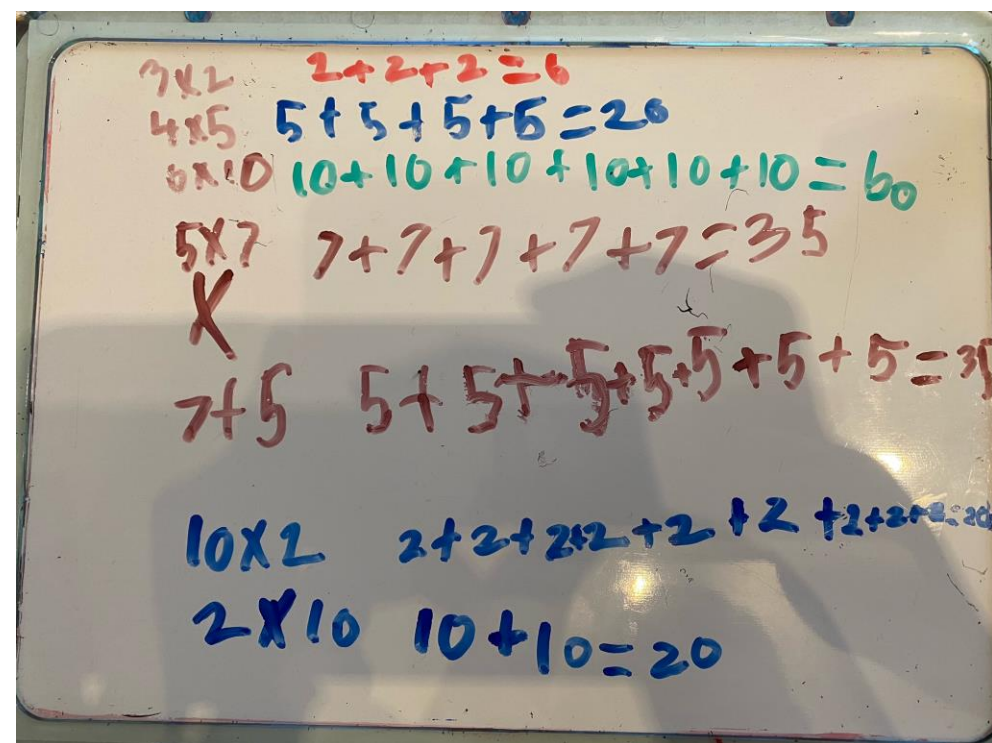
Guided Reading Wednesday 20th Jan

5. Moon face used his magic powers to get to the same land as Joe.

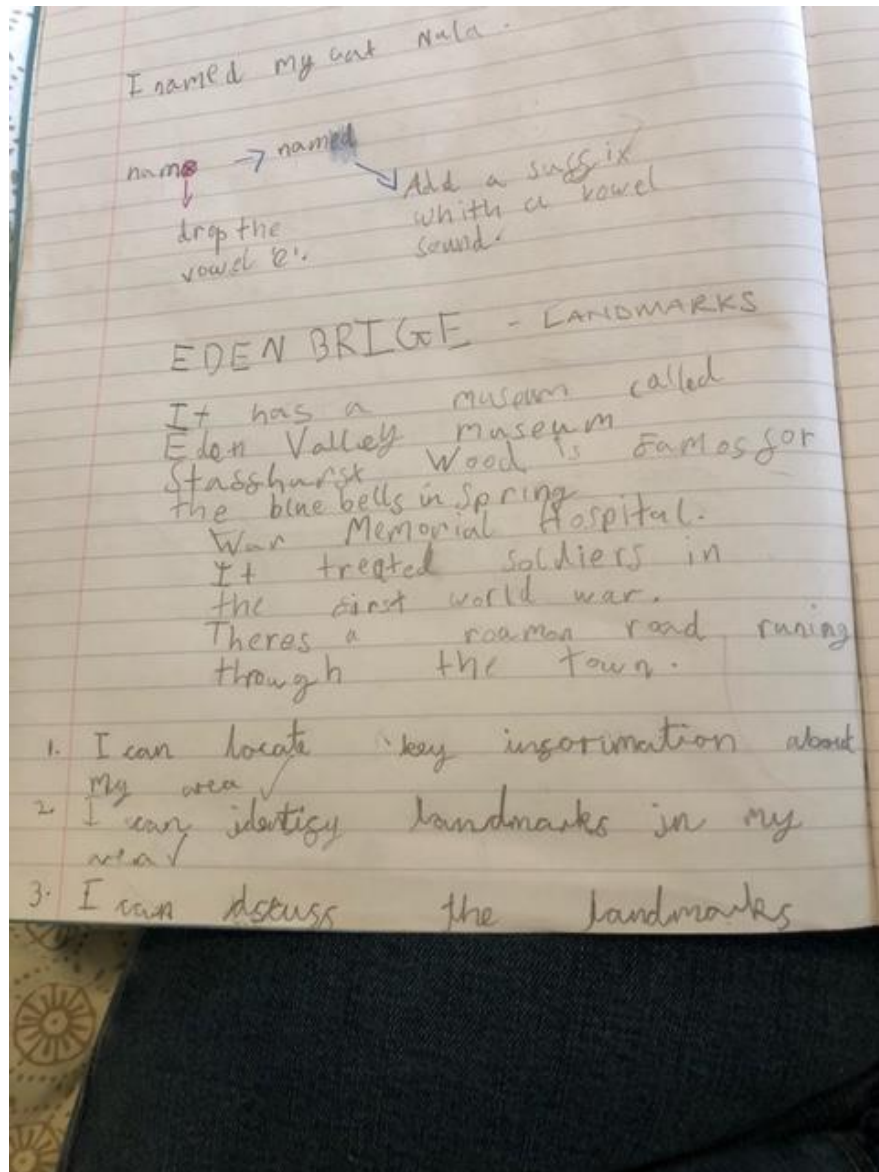
