$$5 + 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = 30$$

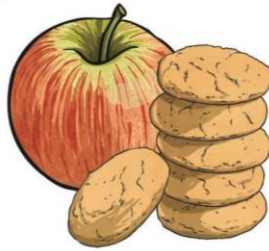
$$10 + 10 + 10 + 10 + 10 = 50$$

Question 4

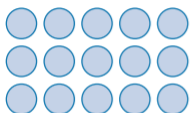
Sally buys 3 cinema tickets costing £5 each. How much does she spend?
