Please note that the RWI phonics scheme is based on lots of repetition. Therefore, we usually read the same book about 3 or 4 times before moving onto a new book. For some children they may need to read it more than this to ensure they are completely fluent in reading the book (no sounding out). A general guide is: 1<sup>st</sup> read – decoding all the words – sound out as much as you need to. $2^{nd}$ read – read for fluency (try to read with more fluency and expression). 3<sup>rd</sup> read – read with fluency, expression and comprehension. Try answering the comprehension questions at the back. This website also provides lots of other information for parents about phonics. It has other resources on here too should you wish to explore! **Guided reading** Complete the guided reading task at the bottom of the webpage. If the reading is taking you longer than the time allocated, then feel free to share the reading with an adult.
