<b>I can sometimes use:</b>	capital letters for names, places, the days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'.	
	finger spaces.	
	full stops to end sentences.	
	question marks.	
	exclamation marks.	
Use Fred Talk to segment my words in order to spell them.		
Spell most Y1 common exception words and days of the week accurately (from English Appendix 1).		
Use -s and -es to form regular plurals correctly.		
Use the prefix 'un'.		
Add the suffixes -ing, -ed, -er and -est to root words (with no change to the root word).		
Write lower case and capital letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.
