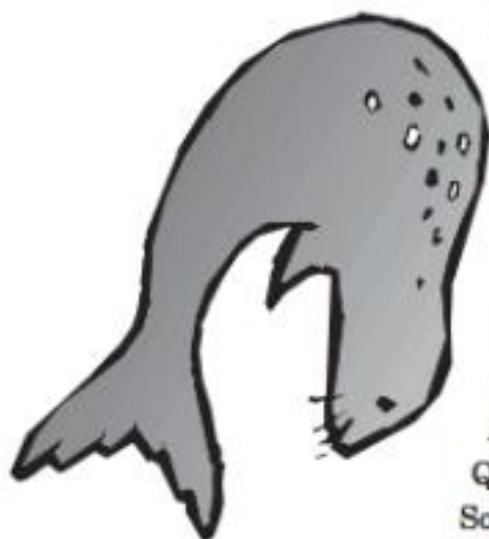


Seal
