

Year 1 Maths Multiplication Outcome Problems – Red Challenge

I forgot that we will need decorations and things to eat our food off of like plates! I need your help to solve the problems to find out how many of each item I might need to buy.

When I went to the shops, I found out that some of the items could be bought in different size packets. I don't know which ones would be best to buy so I need you to solve the problems for each item and use your knowledge of multiplication to tell me which packet would give me more of each item.

balloons can be bought in different size packets which packet would get me more?

A. 5 packets of balloons which have 5 balloons in a packet.

Or

B. 2 packets of balloons which have 10 balloons in a packet.

Plates can be bought in different size packets which packet would get me more?

A. 5 packets of plates which have 10 plates in a packet.

Or

B. 10 packets of plates which have 5 plates in a packet.

cups can be bought in different size packets which packet would get me more?

A. 7 packets of cups which have 5 cups in a packet.

Or

B. 8 packets of cups which have 2 cups in a packet.

straws can be bought in different size packets which packet would get me more?

A. 4 packets of straws which have 10 straws in a packet.

Or

B. 8 packets of straws which have 5 straws in a packet.

napkins can be bought in different size packets which packet would get me more?

A. 4 packets of napkins which have 5 napkins in a packet.

Or

B. 9 packets of napkins which have 2 napkins in a packet.
