



Reading –

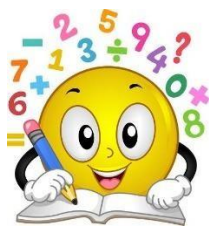
Once you have done this, go onto the Seal Primary website (see above) and down the side, you will see different colours. They correspond to your child's phonics band (this is different to the books they bring home to read usually). If your child is in Miss Clinning's group they need to read the pink books. They can also try the yellow and orange if they wish.

If your child is in Miss Keenor's group, they will read the blue books.

Please note – it is good practise to re-read the RWI books. The RWI phonics relies on repetition.

Maths – **To add amounts of money**

Look at the powerpoint about instruction writing. Look at my example below. How to make vanilla chiffon Easter Cupcakes.

Follow this easy recipe to make 24 delicious chiffon cupcakes. You can also add jam and buttercream to make it extra scrumptious!

Ingredients:

- Jam and buttercream
- 8 egg yolk + whites
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup vegetable oil
- $\frac{2}{3}$ cup water
- $2\frac{1}{4}$ cups self-raising flour
- 1 tablespoon of flour
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- $1\frac{1}{3}$ cup of granulated sugar (split in half)
- $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon of cream of tartar

Equipment:

- Baking tray / tin
- Measuring spoons / cups
- Mixing bowl
- Cupcake cases
- Spoons
- Oven

How to make it:

1. Pre-heat the oven to 160°C .
2. Place cupcake cases into the tin.
3. Carefully sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a bowl then set it aside.
4. In a different bowl whisk egg yolks and sugar. Add in vegetable oil and water.
5. Whisk quickly without spilling the mixture.
6. Tip in the bowl of dried ingredients.
7. Gently fold the mixture until it is smooth then set aside.
8. Make the meringue by whisking egg whites and cream of tartar in a bowl.
 - Gradually add the rest of the sugar.

10. Fold the meringue into the batter.
12. Carefully, spoon the mixture between the cases.
13. Bake in the oven for 25 minutes then allow to cool.
14. Once the cakes are cool, use a spoon to neatly put the buttercream jam on top.
15. Delicately lay either mini eggs or wafer flowers on top.
16. Add other Easter decorations.
17. Enjoy eating the cupcakes!
