## **Home School Agreement**

The Home School Agreement is a document which shows we are all working for the good of the children. All staff, parents and pupils are expected to adhere to these principles.

The schools within The Inspire Academy Movement are Rights Respecting schools and we ask all adults and pupils to adhere to the principals stated in the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. Article 1 states that all children have the rights in the convention.

#### **TOGETHER**

#### We will:

- Support the children's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment
- Work to sort out any problems that may arise (behavioural, educational or social)
- Encourage our children to grow into responsible members of our school and local community, respecting each other; including peers, family members and all adults
- Encourage each child to respect and keep the school rules
- Support children's learning to help each individual achieve their best (Article 29)
- Develop the aspirations of every member of the school community (Article 29)
- Celebrate children's achievements in and out of school
- Recognise the importance of regular attendance and punctuality (Article 18)
- Work to combat discrimination and bullying

#### We will:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that caters for all pupils
- · Provide an environment conducive for learning
- Encourage all children to achieve their best in all aspects of development behaviour, social skills and learning

- Contact parents/guardians if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or behaviour
- Inform parents/guardians of any concerns or problems that affect their child's work and learning
- Set, mark and monitor homework, in accordance with Trust policy
- Arrange parent consultations and send home written reports
- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters/notices and give adequate notice of meetings and events
- Encourage children to take care of their surroundings and others around them
- Encourage children to keep to school rules
- Ensure that we always follow the agreed safeguarding procedures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children at all times
- Behave in a professional manner at all times, following the staff code of conduct

#### PARENTS/GUARDIANS

#### I/We will:

- Ensure that my child attends school every day and provide an explanation if my child is absent
- Read all communications sent home by the school and respond in a timely fashion where required
- Ensure that my child arrives at school on time
- Ensure punctuality in collecting my child at the end of the school day
- Let the school know promptly about any concerns or problems that may affect my child's work or behaviour or wellbeing and communicate these in a way that is respectful
- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning, in accordance with the Trust's homework policy, including providing regular time for my child to read (with or without an adult as appropriate)
- Return reading books or other items that may belong to the school
- Attend parent consultations and discussions about my child's progress
- Support my child to be tidy in appearance and wear agreed school uniform
- Support the policies and decisions of the school
- Ensure my child has the correct PE and swimming kit as appropriate
- Follow the established procedure to voice concerns
- Be a good role model for my child and other pupils
- Park considerately and respectfully, following the guidance in the adult code of conduct
- Be respectful in my behaviour at all times when in school or walking to and from school, including to the car

### **CHILD**

### I will:

- · Follow the school rules and be responsible for my behaviour
- Be polite and helpful to my friends, all children and all adults in the school
- Come to school every day when I am well
- Be kind and considerate and respectful to others both in the classroom and in the playground by respecting each other's' right to be safe
- Be respectful of the people within the local community
- Take care of the school and everything in it
- Respect other children's right to be heard
- Respect other children's right to learn
- Wear proper uniform at all times
