We will:

- Support children's learning to help each individual achieve their best.
- Develop the aspirations of every member of the school community.
- Celebrate children's achievements in and out of school.
- Recognise the importance of regular attendance and punctuality.
- Work to combat discrimination.
- Work against bullying.

SCHOOL

We will:

- Provide an environment conducive for learning.
- Encourage all children to achieve their best in all aspects of development – behaviour, social skills and learning.
- Contact parents/guardians if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or behaviour.
- Inform parents/guardians of any concerns or problems that affect their child's work and learning.
- Set, mark and monitor homework, in accordance with Four Elms Primary's policies.
- Arrange parents' evenings and send home written reports.

- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters/notices and give adequate notice of meetings.
- Encourage children to take care of their surroundings and others around them.
- Encourage children to keep to school rules.
- Ensure that we always follow the agreed safeguarding procedures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children at all times.
- Behave in a professional manner at all times, following the staff code of conduct.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS

I/We will:

- Ensure that my child attends school every day and provide an explanation if my child is absent.
- Ensure that my child arrives at school on time - by 8.45a.m.
- Ensure punctuality in collecting my child at the end of the school. Parents and carers will inform school of alternative arrangements if necessary.
- Let the school know promptly about any concerns or problems that may affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning, in accordance with Seal Primary School's homework policy, including providing time daily for my child to read (with or without an adult as appropriate).
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Get to know about my child's life at the school.
- Support my child to be tidy in appearance and wear agreed school uniform.
- Support the policies of the school.
- Ensure my child takes PE and swimming kit to school as appropriate.
- Follow the established procedure to voice concerns and not through social media.
- Be a good role model for my child and other pupils.

CHILD

I will:

- Follow the school rules and be responsible for my behaviour.
- Be polite and helpful to my friends, all children and all adults in the school.
- Come to school every day.
- Be kind and considerate and respectful to others both in the classroom and in the playground by respecting each other's' right to be safe.
- Take care of the school and everything in it.
- Respect other children's right to be heard.
- Respect other children's right to learn.
- Wear proper uniform at all times.
