I will show perseverance in lessons by considering my options when I reach a barrier.

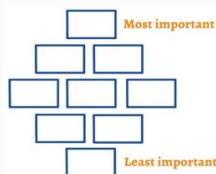
I will show perseverance in my life by taking time to process before reacting.
