This event is actually taking place ON the publication day of her brand-new TOM GATES book, the award-winning and bestselling author-illustrator Liz Pichon will get everyone excited about reading, writing and doodling with her interactive event including storytelling, games, draw-along tips and a Q&A where children can ask Liz questions. Over 16 million Tom Gates books have sold and the 21-book series has won over 25 awards including the Roald Dahl Funny Prize, a Waterstones Children's Book Prize and a Blue Peter Award.
