

Time to plan our stories, for the first part of your lesson I want you to mind map who the main character of your story is going to be. In order for our stories to be different I would like you to work with existing minor characters. I have modelled some options below. Think about how these characters could have their own story. You do not have to use the same one's I have- think about the fairy tales you know and the characters within them who you don't know a lot about (Smee, Hansel and Gretel's parents, the wolf in little red riding hood).



Following that you need to choose 1 to work with. We are now going to use subtitles to plan out the story. You need to think about the following areas:

- Main character
- Other characters
- Magical event
- Problem
- Resolution
- Ending
- Moral

See my plan below for how this should be done.

Story plan


Main character: Gaston - He is an insecure man who has many fears, but hides them by pretending to be arrogant and brave. He has been in love with Belle for years and wishes he had the courage to ask her to be his wife.

Other characters: Belle - judgmental, stuck up but beautiful girl Gaston loves.
Le fou - Gaston's helpful best friend.

The Witch - a travelling witch wanting to practice her new magic she is a bit clumsy, but means well.

Magical event: Le fou asks the witch for a magical potion that will give his friend some more confidence.

Problem: The potion works too well and makes Gaston too confident. Le fou desperately has to search for the witch whilst Gaston is causing chaos.


Personal choice

- Work on your 2020 year of change activity to become really good at something.


- Write a letter to Betty or another resident of the care home (unfortunately, Joan has moved back in with her family and we do not have a forwarding address for her).
